7 March 2024

Rohan held an informative and hands-on session on tool care and maintenance.

14 March 2024

21 March 2024

Kate is back and along with Sue visited Rohan's shed on a very wet day. Rohan held another useful session on maintenace of tools and provided hands-on practical advice.



28 March 2024

Paul, Kate, Rohan and Sue attended a course, "Provide First Aid" conducteded by Fireground. Damo and Karra were fabulous presenters and BRW participants are now proficient in the delivery of CPR, basic emergency life support and first aid.



4 April 2024

The weather was slated to be inclement so rather than pull narrow-leaf privet we walked the tracks and assessed past plantings. A possible platypus sighting was made by Paulette, Rohan and Paul. Sue and Kate were busy looking elsewhere! Future works were discussed at the debrief held at Components Cafe.



11 April 2024

Rohan worked on 'cobbler's pegs' near twin seats, Paulette and Paul used privet remover to remove privet and Kate cut down ink weed as they are now seeding. At the debrief, Paul stepped everyone through the QGIS program for geolocation on BRW. Jason from Bellingen Landcare joined us for the debrief.



18 April 2024

Rohan, Sue, Kate and Paulette took to the privet removing implements and cleared a patch of privet downstream from the pumphouse. Paul wielded the whipper-snipper to clear the walking track and other areas. At the debrief, we signed off on the Safe Work Methods Statement and spoke to Lyn about grant opportunities and protocols involved when applying through Dorrigo Community Nursery Inc.







25 April 2024

Work at BRW was substituted with a Neighbourhood planting along Tyringham Road verge near Paul's place. Thirty tea tree tubestock were planted.
